

Cookie & Tracking Notice

Integrative Medicine Chamber of Commerce (IMCC)

1. Scope

This Cookie & Tracking Notice explains how the Integrative Medicine Chamber of Commerce (IMCC) and service providers supporting imcc.us may use cookies and similar technologies. It should be read together with the IMCC Privacy Policy.

2. Cookies and Similar Technologies

Cookies are small data files stored on or accessed from a browser or device. Similar technologies may include local storage, pixels, tags, software identifiers, and comparable tools. They can support website operation, login sessions, preferences, security, payments, performance measurement, and embedded content.

3. Categories of Technologies

3.1 Strictly necessary and functional

These technologies support essential website functions such as page delivery, login sessions, account access, security, load balancing, consent preferences, forms, and fraud prevention. The website may not function properly if they are blocked.

3.2 Security and anti-abuse

Security services may use cookies, device information, network information, and other signals to detect bots, prevent attacks, limit abuse, protect accounts, and maintain website availability.

3.3 Payment

When a payment feature is used, the payment processor may use cookies or similar technologies to complete the transaction, authenticate the user, prevent fraud, and secure the payment process. Those technologies are governed by the processor's own notices.

3.4 Preferences

Preference technologies may remember selections such as privacy choices, display settings, language, or account-related options so they do not need to be entered repeatedly.

3.5 Analytics and performance

IMCC may use limited analytics or performance technologies to understand aggregate website use, diagnose errors, and improve content and services. Nonessential analytics will be used only with any consent required by applicable law and will not be intentionally configured to collect message content, complete payment-card information, or private directory contact information.

3.6 Embedded content

Video, audio, maps, documents, or other embedded services may place or receive identifiers when their features are used. IMCC may use privacy-enhanced configurations where reasonably available.

3.7 Advertising technologies

IMCC does not use advertising or retargeting technologies unless their use is disclosed and any legally required choice or consent is provided.

4. Your Choices

Available website controls may allow you to accept, reject, or change choices for nonessential technologies. Most browsers also allow you to delete or block cookies. Blocking necessary technologies may prevent login, payment, forms, or other website functions from operating correctly.

Where applicable law requires recognition of a legally valid browser-based opt-out preference signal, IMCC will process that signal as required.

5. Third-Party Services

Third-party services used by IMCC may set or receive cookies or similar identifiers when their features are used. IMCC does not control every technology used by an independent provider. Information handled by those providers is also subject to their own privacy and cookie notices.

6. Retention

The duration of a cookie or similar identifier depends on its purpose. Session technologies generally expire when the browser session ends, while persistent technologies may remain until their expiration date or deletion. IMCC and its service providers retain identifiers only for as long as reasonably necessary for the function they support or as required by law.

7. Changes to This Notice

IMCC may revise this Notice to reflect changes in website technologies, services, or legal obligations. The revised Notice will be posted with a new effective date, and any additional notice or consent required by law will be provided.
