

Website & Membership Terms

Integrative Medicine Chamber of Commerce (IMCC)

Effective date: August 21, 2026 | Version 1.1

1. Acceptance of These Terms

These Website & Membership Terms (Terms) govern use of imcc.us and website-operated services provided by the Integrative Medicine Chamber of Commerce (IMCC), including accounts, paid memberships, member directories, forums, resources, and other services that link to these Terms. By using the website or creating an account, you agree to these Terms. If you do not agree, do not use member-only services or create an account.

2. About IMCC

IMCC is an Alaska nonprofit corporation recognized as tax-exempt under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(6). IMCC is a membership and business-league organization. It is not a healthcare provider, licensing authority, credentialing body, insurer, law firm, financial adviser, or government agency.

3. Eligibility and Accounts

You must be at least 18 years old and legally capable of entering into an agreement to create a paid account or membership. You agree to provide accurate information, keep account information reasonably current, protect your login credentials, and promptly report suspected unauthorized access. You are responsible for activity occurring through your account unless prohibited by law. Accounts are personal to the authorized member or designated organizational representative and may not be sold, transferred, shared, or used to provide unauthorized access to another person.

4. Membership

Available membership categories, levels, prices, and benefits are described on the website or during enrollment. Membership access and benefits are determined by the selected membership level and any applicable written offer. IMCC may verify eligibility information and may correct an account placed in an inapplicable category.

Membership does not create ownership, voting, governance, partnership, agency, employment, fiduciary, or joint-venture rights. IMCC membership dues and sponsorship payments are not charitable contributions and are not represented as tax-deductible charitable donations.

5. Fees, Taxes, and Payment

You agree to pay the fees and applicable taxes disclosed before purchase. Payments may be processed by an independent payment processor under its own terms. IMCC may suspend or limit paid access when a charge is declined, reversed, disputed, overdue, or reasonably suspected of fraud. You are responsible for keeping payment and billing information current.

6. Renewal Choice

When renewal options are offered, the purchaser must affirmatively select either manual renewal or automatic renewal before payment. Automatic renewal authorizes IMCC or its payment processor to charge the selected payment method at the disclosed interval and price until

automatic renewal is canceled. IMCC will provide material renewal terms and any notices required by applicable law.

7. Cancellation

A member may cancel future renewal through an available account control or by a verified request to IMCC. IMCC will provide a reasonably simple cancellation method consistent with applicable law. Cancellation stops future renewal but ordinarily does not end access before the conclusion of the already-paid membership term. A cancellation request received after a renewal charge has been processed applies to the next renewal unless applicable law requires otherwise.

8. Refunds

Except as required by applicable law, paid membership dues and fees are nonrefundable after payment. IMCC may issue a refund for a duplicate charge, a verified billing error, or another exception expressly approved in writing by IMCC. Cancellation alone does not create a prorated refund for an already-paid term.

9. Founding Sponsors and Separate Agreements

Founding Sponsor opportunities are separate from standard membership and are governed by the applicable written sponsorship or founding agreement. Any lifetime designation, recognition, access, benefit, or other right associated with a Founding Sponsor is controlled by that signed agreement. These Terms do not expand or reduce rights created by a separate written agreement.

10. Benefits, Programs, and Website Changes

IMCC may add, modify, replace, suspend, or discontinue website features, member benefits, programs, content, and service providers as organizational needs change. A feature identified as planned, proposed, beta, pilot, or under development is not guaranteed until it is made available. Changes do not alter rights expressly guaranteed in a separate signed agreement.

11. Member Directory

Directory information is supplied by or for members and is provided for professional networking. A listing is not an IMCC endorsement, referral, credential verification, licensing determination, or guarantee. Members are responsible for the accuracy and legality of their listings. Users must not scrape, harvest, resell, republish, or use directory information for spam, harassment, discrimination, or unlawful solicitation.

12. Forum and User Content

You retain ownership of content you submit, subject to the rights needed to operate the service. By submitting content, you grant IMCC a nonexclusive, worldwide, royalty-free license to host, store, reproduce, display, format, and distribute that content as reasonably necessary to operate, secure, moderate, and promote the relevant IMCC service.

You represent that you have the rights needed to submit your content and that it does not violate law, another person's rights, confidentiality duties, or these Terms. IMCC may remove, restrict, preserve, or disclose content when reasonably necessary to enforce rules, protect users, comply with law, or maintain service integrity. IMCC is not obligated to monitor every submission.

13. Acceptable Use

You may not use IMCC services to:

- Violate law, professional duties, intellectual-property rights, privacy rights, or contractual obligations.
- Impersonate another person, misrepresent credentials or affiliation, or submit materially false or deceptive information.
- Harass, threaten, discriminate against, exploit, defame, or invade the privacy of another person.
- Transmit malware, bypass security, probe vulnerabilities, disrupt service, automate unauthorized access, or interfere with another user.
- Send spam, harvest data, conduct unauthorized commercial solicitation, or use member information outside the purpose for which access was provided.
- Provide individualized medical diagnosis or treatment through a nonclinical IMCC feature or submit private medical records through general website channels.

14. Health and Professional Information

IMCC content and member-generated content are informational and do not constitute medical, legal, financial, tax, or other individualized professional advice. Use of the website does not create a clinician-patient relationship. Additional terms are stated in the IMCC Medical & Health Information Disclaimer.

15. Third-Party Services and Links

The website may use or link to independent services for payments, hosting, security, communications, media, or other functions. Those services may be governed by separate terms and privacy notices. IMCC is not responsible for the availability, content, security, products, or practices of independent third parties.

16. Privacy and Cookies

IMCC's handling of personal information is described in the Privacy Policy. The use of cookies and similar technologies is described in the Cookie & Tracking Notice. Those documents are incorporated into these Terms by reference.

17. IMCC Intellectual Property

Unless otherwise stated, IMCC owns or licenses the website design, name, marks, logos, original text, graphics, publications, and other IMCC-created content. You may use website content for lawful personal or internal professional purposes. You may not reproduce, republish, sell, scrape, remove ownership notices from, or commercially exploit IMCC content without permission, except as permitted by law.

18. Feedback

If you voluntarily provide an idea, suggestion, or feedback about IMCC services, IMCC may use it without restriction or compensation, provided that this provision does not transfer ownership of your preexisting intellectual property or override a separate written confidentiality agreement.

19. Suspension and Termination

IMCC may restrict, suspend, or terminate access when it reasonably believes an account presents a security risk, violates these Terms or other applicable rules, infringes rights, involves fraud or nonpayment, threatens another person, or exposes IMCC to legal or operational harm. When

appropriate, IMCC may provide notice and an opportunity to address the issue. Provisions that by their nature should survive termination remain effective.

20. Disclaimers

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the website and services are provided on an “as available” basis. IMCC does not guarantee uninterrupted or error-free access, continued availability of a particular feature, professional referrals, leads, sales, rankings, revenue, reimbursement, clinical outcomes, or the accuracy of third-party or member-generated content. Nothing in these Terms excludes a warranty or right that cannot lawfully be excluded.

21. Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law, IMCC and its officers, directors, employees, agents, and service providers will not be liable for indirect, incidental, special, consequential, exemplary, or punitive damages arising from the website or services. IMCC’s aggregate liability arising from standard website use or membership will not exceed the amount paid to IMCC by the claimant during the 12 months preceding the event giving rise to the claim. This limitation does not apply where prohibited by law or to obligations governed by a separate written agreement.

22. Indemnification

To the extent permitted by law, you agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless IMCC and its officers, directors, employees, and agents from claims, losses, liabilities, and reasonable costs arising from your unlawful conduct, your content, your infringement of another person’s rights, or your material violation of these Terms. IMCC may control the defense of a covered claim, and you agree to provide reasonable cooperation.

23. Governing Law and Venue

These Terms are governed by the laws of the State of Alaska, without regard to conflict-of-law principles. Except where applicable law requires otherwise, any legal action arising from these Terms or IMCC’s website services must be brought in a state court located in Anchorage, Alaska, or in the United States District Court for the District of Alaska, and each party consents to that jurisdiction and venue.

24. General Provisions

If any provision of these Terms is unenforceable, it will be limited or removed only as necessary; the remaining provisions will remain effective. Failure to enforce a provision is not a waiver. You may not assign your account or these Terms without IMCC’s written consent; IMCC may assign them in a lawful organizational transfer. These Terms, incorporated policies, and applicable written agreements govern the relevant service.

25. Changes to These Terms

IMCC may revise these Terms. Revised Terms will be posted with a new effective date and any notice or consent required by law. Continued use after the effective date constitutes acceptance to the extent permitted by law.
